- Include all appropriate staff members..always include the Special Education teacher!



# Technology Usage Tips

- 1) Power down Chromebooks EVERY NIGHT!
  - Not the same as just closing the lid!
  - Allow for updates which improves functionality

2) Only have open necessary tabs to avoid a power strain.

3) Get a better signal by moving closer to the Wifi source.

#### See two windows at the same time


- 1. On one of the windows you want to see, click and hold Maximize

- 2. Drag to the left or right arrow < >.
- 3. Repeat for a second window.


